I must be able to view the student's application in the system at the time of review. We no longer process hard copy applications. 2. Official high school transcript (in hard copy) in a sealed envelope (or some other type of indicator confirming its authenticity). 3. Official SAT and/or ACT test scores in hard copy. The score reports must include the student's full name and address. Screenshots will not be accepted at the time of review. Our minimum admission requirements include: i. Cumulative GPA of 2.5; ii. SAT score of 930; iii. ACT composite score of 18; iv. Recommendation letters and personal statements are optional. Students who do not meet the minimum qualifications in one or more of the categories are still encouraged to apply.
